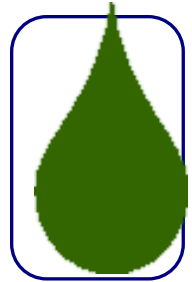
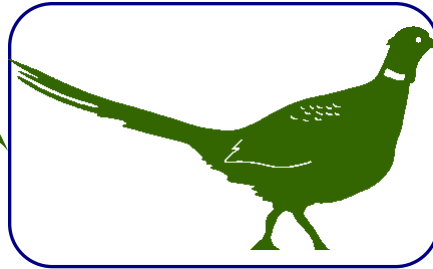


# OKI-RCC TOUR

- At Beckett Park you will see wetland enhancement, rain gardens, and a restored timber-frame barn from the 1880s. Close by is the Upper Mill Creek Riparian Restoration and Storm Water Wetland Enhancement Project that we will discuss and present on the related storm water concepts.
- Talawanda High School: The Erik Sustainability Initiative including restoration of wetlands, forest and prairie. This stop will include the partnership with the Butler County Stream Team volunteer water quality monitoring program.
- Geddes Farm in Reily Township has been in conservation easement since 2005 and includes 3 agriculture wetlands, 15 acres of tall grass prairie and oak/hickory savannah.
